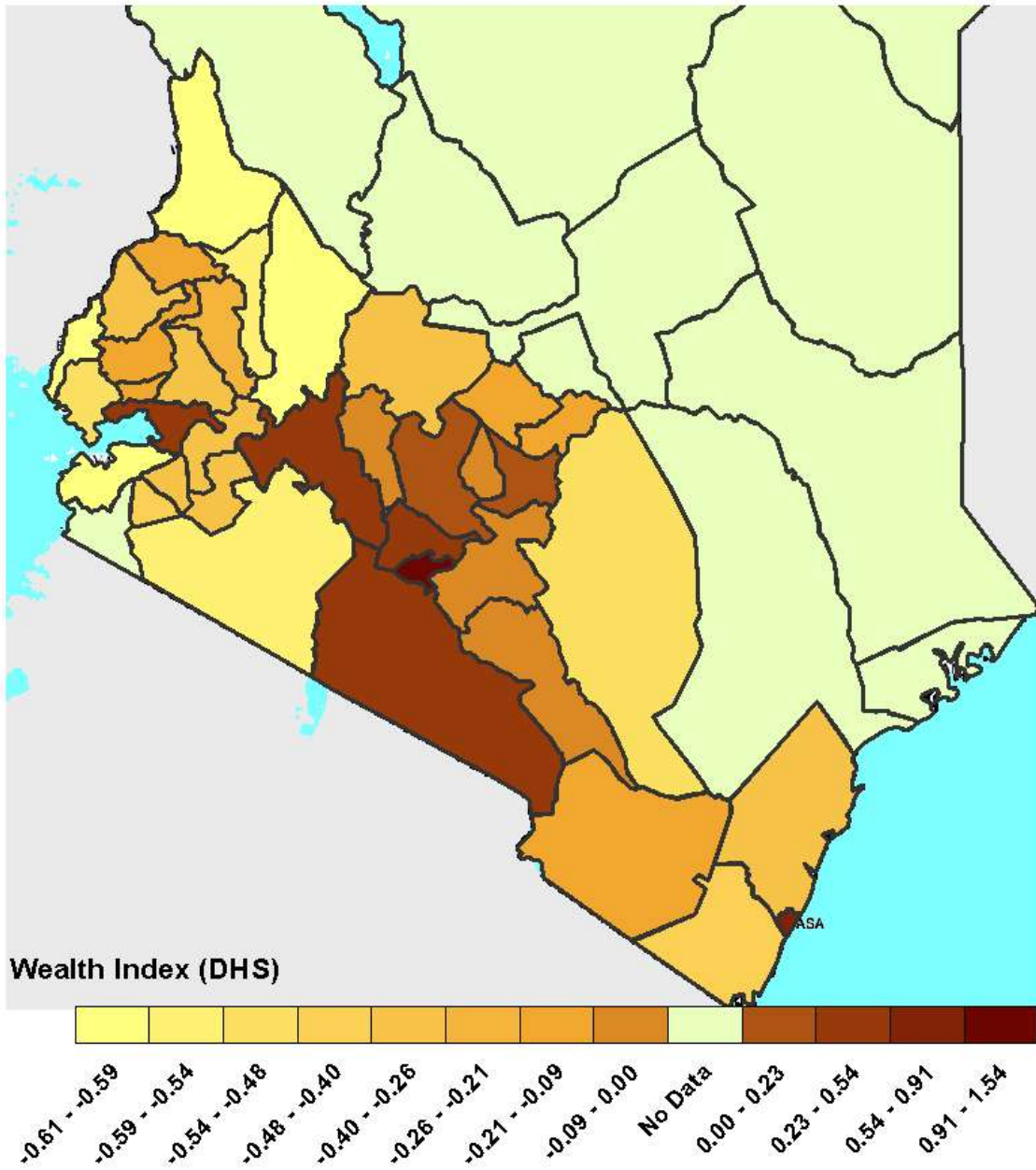
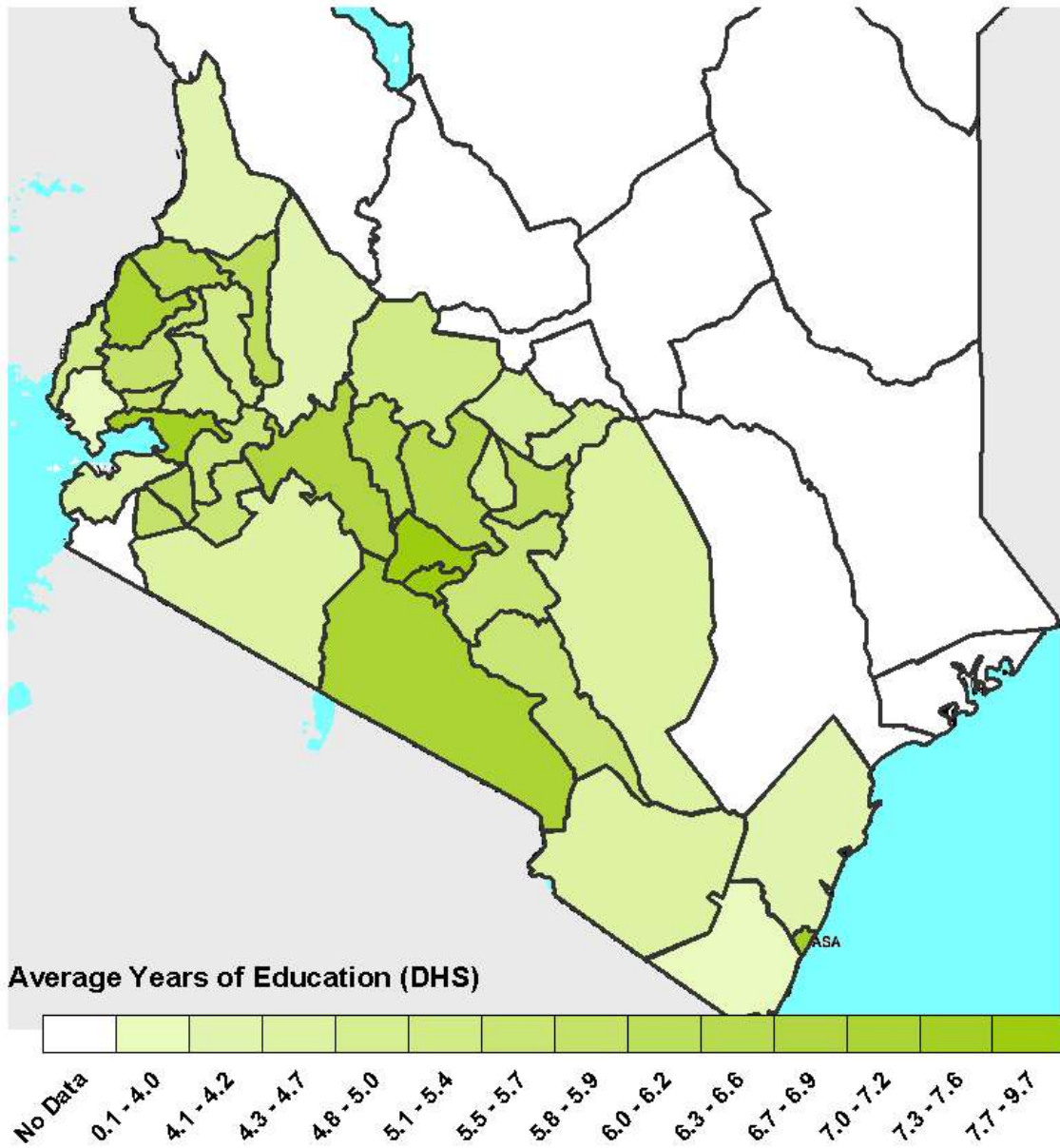




Appendix B: Wealth index variation, DHS+ survey
